HOLIDAY SAFETY TIPS

Broilers on stoves should not be used for storage, as some items may cause fires or damage. Always remember to remove any items before using.

As cooler weather approaches, we recommend running your furnace now to ensure it's in good working condition before you need it daily. Don't be alarmed if you notice a slight odor the first time it runs. This is normal, as dust burns off after months of inactivity. If the smell lingers, call the Maintenance Service line at (478) 310-2788.

Most home fires start in the kitchen, and Thanksgiving is the leading day for kitchen fires in the US. Nearly four times the average daily number of kitchen fires occur on this holiday. Remember to stay in the kitchen when cooking. Never walk away, even for a short moment, and never leave your home while food is cooking in the oven.

In the event of a fire, remember:

For a grease fire: Slide a lid over the pan to smother the flames and turn off the burner. Do not use water!

For an oven fire: Turn off the heat and keep the door closed.

Most importantly, if in doubt or the fire grows, evacuate immediately and call 911.

Decorating the home is a long-standing tradition around the holidays, but it is important to practice good safety habits when choosing decorations. In homes with small children, it is important to avoid holiday decorations that are breakable or contain sharp edges. Keep decorations with small parts out of the reach of children and avoid trimmings that look like candy or food, as they may attract extra attention from children.
