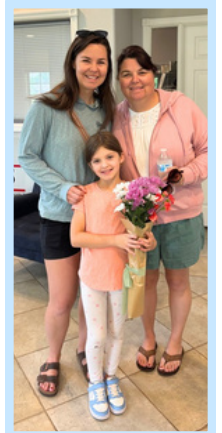


COMMUNITY TRASH SCHEDULE

MAINTENANCE TIPS

A well-running plumbing system is one of those things we rarely think about... until something goes wrong. Recently, our maintenance team has noticed an increase in pipe blockages throughout the community, and the leading cause is something many people don't realize is harmful: pouring grease, fats, and cooking oils down the sink.

Even when grease looks liquid and harmless, it cools quickly once it enters the pipes. Over time, it hardens, sticks to the inside of the plumbing, and traps food particles. What starts as a thin coating can grow into a major obstruction.

What Happens When Grease Goes Down the Drain

Grease buildup isn't just a minor inconvenience. It can lead to:

- Serious clogs that slow or stop water flow
- Sewage backups that can affect multiple homes
- Costly repairs to both private plumbing and shared infrastructure
- Unpleasant odors and sanitation issues
- Large blockages ("fatbergs") in the municipal sewer system

These problems are preventable, but only if everyone participates.



Simple Habits That Make a Big Difference

A few small changes in the kitchen can protect the entire community:

- Let grease cool, then scrape it into the trash
- Pour used cooking oil into a disposable container and throw it away
- Wipe pans and plates with a paper towel before washing
- Use a sink strainer to catch food scraps

These steps take only a moment but help prevent major plumbing issues.



Self-Help Program

This is a great time to take advantage of our Self-Help Program, which provides lawnmowers and weed trimmers for resident use. These tools are available for checkout during normal office hours and can help you keep your fenced-in yards neat and well-maintained. If you'd like to borrow equipment, simply stop by the office and a team member will be glad to assist you.

Replace Your HVAC Filter

Please also remember to change your HVAC air filter each month. Regular filter changes improve air quality and help your system operate efficiently, especially during peak cooling season. Replacement filters are available at no cost through the Self-Help Program. If you have any questions or need assistance, please feel free to contact the Housing Office at (478) 310-2788.
