### **Community Reminder**

Please remember that the speed limit in our base housing community is 15 miles per hour. This speed limit is 24/7 and is enforced. With the oncoming fall, there are going to be more people out and about and we encourage that!

Please stop at all crosswalks if someone is waiting to cross and make sure that someone is not in the crosswalk as you approach! Stopping at stop signs is also enforced. Please ensure you come to a complete stop and assess the surrounding area before proceeding. We have had some very scary near misses recently that have been reported, and they are avoidable! Safety is everyone's responsibility!

From this feedback we have improved our lawn care process, gate and new access gate system, helped facilitate a neighborhood watch program, enhanced partnering, and encouraged the presence of security forces as well as local law enforcement in the neighborhoods.

### **Maintenance Corner**

Let's Talk ACs! Although we are coming to the end of our summer, we still have some hot days to deal with. We are finding many homes have their thermostats set to an unreachable temperature, causing the AC to run constantly without shutting down. This is causing two major problems.

- 1. The motors do not have their normal cool down period, around 20-30 minutes, and we have replaced many in the last couple months.
- 2. The AC ducts to not have time to rid themselves of moisture causing excessive condensation leading to possible growth issues.

Please realize that an air conditioner is built to cool the home and make it more comfortable but will not make a home cold when the exterior temperature is 90+ with high humidity. We respectfully request you refrain from having the thermostat set below 70 degrees, as being set at 72-76 degrees will ensure the home stays comfortable compared to the 90+ outside temp. This will ensure your unit continues to run properly.
