Maintenance Corner

Air Conditioning Tips:

1. Run the A/C before you actually need it. There's nothing worse than turning on the A/C and all you feel is a blast of hot air, so be sure to test the system before the warm days hit.
2. Avoid turning the A/C off completely. Instead, you should increase the temperature when you are away from home. The A/C unit may run when you're not home for a few minutes at a time, but this is more energy efficient than turning it on when you get home. Running the unit at full blast is more costly than keeping it on consistently.
3. Another great idea is to shut your blinds and close your drapes to keep the heat out, not only in the summer but year-round.

Toilets Tips:

1. If your toilet is backed up, insert a plunger into the toilet at a slight angle, covering the drain. Hold onto the plunger handle with both hands and slowly, but forcefully, plunge the drain. If the first attempt fails, try again. Contact the leasing office or after hours maintenance line if the clog cannot be removed.
2. If your toilet is leaking, turn the water valve off and contact the leasing office or call the after hours maintenance line.
