Friendly Reminders

Please be mindful of children walking to and from school buses. Speeding is never permitted in the community! With kids lining up and running to catch buses we can never be too careful!

Please make sure that front porches and carports are kept free of any debris that is not outdoor furniture or decoration. If gourds, corn husks, or any other autumn décor that is capable of perishing is used. PLEASE make sure that it is removed once it begins to decay.

Garbage bins are expected to be removed from the roadside same day of trash pickup. Removing the bins will help prevent and protect children who may run into the road unseen, provide residents use of the sidewalk, and prevent unwanted pests such as raccoons and birds from making a mess. This will give our neighborhoods a fresh and clean appearance.

Community Reminder

Please remember that the speed limit in our base housing community is 15 miles per hour. This speed limit is 24/7, and is enforced. With the oncoming fall, there are going to be more people out and about and we encourage that!

Please stop at all crosswalks if someone is waiting to cross, and make sure that someone is not in the crosswalk as you approach! Stopping at stop signs is also enforced.
