## Quick Cooks Recipe

### **Cranberry-Orange Sauce**

You need only four ingredients and 25 minutes to make 5-star cranberry sauce. No one will believe something this tasty takes such little effort.

#### **INGREDIENTS**

Two 8-ounce packages cranberries, fresh or frozen  
1 orange (zest cut into strips and juiced)  
½ cup sugar  
1 cinnamon stick

#### **DIRECTIONS**

Put all the ingredients into a saucepan over medium heat and simmer until the cranberries burst and the sauce thickens, about 15 to 20 minutes. Serve at room temperature or cool and refrigerate. Remove the cinnamon stick before serving.
