Breast Cancer Awareness Month

The power of pink is everywhere this October as we observe Breast Cancer Awareness Month. This yearly event is more than just a way to raise funds for breast cancer research. It helps to increase awareness for the second leading cause of cancer deaths in women. Other than skin cancer, breast cancer is the most common cancer among American women. Mammograms are the best way to find breast cancer early, when it is easier to treat and before it is big enough to feel or cause symptoms. Each year in the United States, about 255,000 women get breast cancer and 42,000 women die from the disease. Men also get breast cancer, but it is not very common. About 1 out of every 100 breast cancers diagnosed in the United States is found in a man. Most breast cancers are found in women who are 50 years old or older, but breast cancer also affects younger women.

Drive Extra Safely on Halloween

Slow down and be especially alert in residential neighborhoods. Children are excited on Halloween and may move in unpredictable ways. Stay well below the posted speed limit and have your headlights on at all times. Do not pass other vehicles that have stopped in the roadway, they could be dropping off children. Do not assume children can see you or are paying attention. Yield to all pedestrians that are in crosswalks. Take extra time to look for kids at intersections, between parked cars, in the street, on medians and on curbs. Enter and exit driveways and alleys slowly and carefully and use your orange cones when parking. Eliminate any distractions inside your vehicle so you can concentrate on the road and your surroundings, do not use a cell phone or text while driving through neighborhoods. Drive slowly, anticipate heavy pedestrian traffic and turn your headlights on earlier in the day to spot children from greater distances. Popular trick-or-treating hours are 6:00 p.m. to 8:00 p.m. so be especially alert for kids during those hours.



