#### **Mold Prevention Tips**

Remove lint every time you use the dryer. Don't hang wet laundry indoors. Turn the bathroom fan on when you shower. When you are done with your shower, leave the bathroom fan on for 30 minutes to remove the remaining moisture from the room. Keep surfaces that get wet, such as the walls around the bathtub and shower, clean and dry. Take out the garbage daily to prevent odors and spoiling. Don't overcrowd closets. Leave room in every closet for air circulation. If you landscape areas around your home, allow for proper water drainage.

#### **Bicycle Awareness**

• Wear a properly fitted bicycle helmet.

- Check Your Equipment: Before riding, inflate the tires properly and check that your brakes work.
- Go With the Traffic Flow: Ride on the right in the same direction as other vehicles. Go with the flow not against it.
- Obey All Traffic Laws: A bicycle is a vehicle and you're a driver. When you ride in the street, obey all traffic signs, signals, and lane markings.
- See and Be Seen: Whether daytime, dawn, dusk, foul weather, or at night, you need to be seen by others. Wearing white has not been shown to make you more visible. Rather, always wear neon, fluorescent, or other bright colors when riding day or night.
