The HHF scholarship program assists active-duty Service members, National Guard or Reservists of one of the five branches of the United States Armed Services or their dependents who plan to continue their education in college or vocational school programs.

COMMUNITY ANNOUNCEMENTS

With PCS season around the corner, we would like to take this time to remind all residents about the required steps for smooth PCS-ing, retiring, or otherwise separating from service transition. A Notice to Vacate is a lease requirement via a written/email request.

Robins Family Housing requires a mandatory Notice to Vacate (NTV) of at least (30) days prior to departing from the home, with exception of short orders.
